TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Relating to Rights-Managed Image Licence Sales from Birmingham Museums Trust

General Terms

Subject to the terms of this Agreement, Birmingham Museums Trust ('BMT') grants to the Licensee a one-time, non-transferable, non-exclusive (unless otherwise agreed in writing) licence, on payment of the Licence Fee, to reproduce the Images during the licence period, in the territory and for the purposes specified in this agreement.

Use of the Images is strictly limited to the purpose, medium, licence period, print run, placement, size of licensed material, territory and any other terms agreed. Unless otherwise agreed, the Licence is for single use, meaning a reproduction in one size for one edition of a single publication in one medium only, published in one language only. A single edition is defined as one bearing a single ISBN number. Additional permission for any other use must be applied for separately in writing. This includes re-prints, further and associated print and electronic editions. The Licence only comes into effect on payment in full of the Licence Fee.

Payment

BMT requires advance payment for the image licensing. In the case of Licensees who have asked for an invoice, payment terms are strictly 30 days from the issue date on the invoice. The breach of such terms will result in the cancellation of discounts and fees will be charged at the standard applicable rate. No reproduction of any Image is authorised until payment in full has been received by BMT. Any reproduction by the Licensee before payment in full has been received constitutes an infringement of copyright and a breach of this Agreement entitling BMT to terminate this Agreement immediately on written notice to the Licensee.

Any VAT numbers must be stated at the time of purchase, VAT cannot be added or deducted retrospectively.

Payments made in currencies other than GB Pounds (£GBP) will be subject to a £5.00 transaction fee.

Cancellations & Refunds

Provided you have not used the images, you may cancel the Licence within 30 days of the issue of the invoice, however administration fees will apply.

If you cancel within 30 days after the invoice date, a cancellation and administrative fee of 50% of the invoice will be charged.

No cancellations will be accepted or refunds given for unused image licences after 30 days and the full amount of the invoice must be paid.

Copyright

BMT takes no responsibility for any additional copyrights e.g. Artists Copyright. It is the Licensees who must satisfy themselves that any additional consent required for reproduction is obtained and the Licensee is solely responsible for obtaining consents, licences or permissions that may apply and the Licence is conditional in each case on the Licensee obtaining them.

BMT reserves the publication right in all images it makes available, whether or not they have been previously published in any form.

The minimum acknowledgement required is the name of the artist and title and the credit line: 'Photo © Birmingham Museums Trust'. 50% of the original fee will be charged for incorrect or insufficient acknowledgements.

Digital Files

Images must not be passed to third parties without the consent of BMT unless this is necessary for the creation of the publications and products where the licensed image will appear. The duplication and storage of files beyond the term of the specified project in any form and by any means is strictly prohibited.

Images shall not be altered or manipulated, added to or have any part cropped or deleted without the prior written consent by BMT. Applications for cropping, manipulation, overlaying and superimposed type must be accompanied by a layout sketch or mock-up.

Where photos are licensed for use in digital media only digital files of maximum 1080 pixels on the largest side should be used at 72 dpi. The appropriate credit should accompany the image both in the form of embedded metadata and alongside the image wherever it appears in the digital product.

Delivery policy

All images are delivered by email or via a third party file sharing service, such as WeTransfer.

Miscellaneous Terms

In the event of the Licensee's insolvency, bankruptcy or death no transfer of ownership in rights or materials from BMT shall be deemed to have occurred other than those properly licensed by BMT. Materials produced by the Licensee containing images from BMT shall be considered to be infringing copyright unless rights have been fully paid for and licensed by BMT. Therefore such products may not be used to settle the Licensee's outstanding liabilities without first settling any outstanding invoices due to BMT from the Licensee.

The Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold BMT harmless against any claims, damages, losses, expenses or costs (including any direct, indirect or consequential losses, loss of profit and loss of reputation and all interest, penalties and legal costs and other expenses) arising in any manner whatsoever from or as a result of the Licensee's unauthorised use of any Image supplied by BMT to the Licensee, or any other breach by the Licensee of any of the Licensee's obligations under this Agreement.

BMT requires one complimentary copy of each product including, in digital media, access to inspect the full functionality of a product, for the duration of the licence. BMT reserves the right to use a photo or a description of a licensed product or service to promote its licensing activities.

No failure or delay by BMT to exercise any right or remedy provided under this Agreement or by law shall constitute a waiver of that or any other right or remedy, nor shall it preclude or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy. No single or partial exercise of such right or remedy shall preclude or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy.

BMT reserves the right to change these Conditions at any time but no changes will affect a transaction once entered into.

This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with English law and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
