High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM.

We're preparing for our future utility works.

Over the coming months, we'll be working on roads in central Birmingham to help us plan our future utility diversions and prepare for the construction of the railway.

We'll be carrying out temporary road closures.

To carry out the utility surveys safely, we need to manage traffic in the area. This will include temporary, phased road closures. We'll carry out the surveys in phases, rather than all at once, to keep disruption to a minimum.

We'll be carrying out works on **New Canal Street** and **Curzon Street** (see tables and maps on pages 2 and 3). **Access to properties will be maintained** throughout the works. Local diversions will be in place and we'll put up signage to explain these changes to road users and pedestrians.

We have planned traffic management.

We will be carrying out works on the following dates:

- **New Canal Street;** 21 March to 3 April, 4 April to 12 April and 15 April to 24 April (phased road closures)
- **Curzon Street;** 25 April to 10 May and 13 May to 20 May

This schedule is **subject to change** depending on site and weather conditions, but we'll keep you informed of any adjustments via www.hs2inbirmingham.commonplace.is

Duration of work

Works will take place from 21 March to 20 May 2019.

Core working hours are 8am to 6pm, although staff may be on site up to an hour before and hour after those times.

Traffic management will be in place **beyond these times**.

What to expect

There will be some temporary road closures.

There will be clearly signed diversion routes in place and this could lead to journey times being a bit longer than usual.

There will be some noise created by these works, but we will keep this to a minimum.

What we will do

Clearly signpost closures and diversion routes.

Keep disruption to a minimum.

Answer your questions via the 24/7 HS2 helpdesk.



Phase 2: Road closure in place on New Canal Street between junctions with Fazeley Street and Bordesley Street. Diversion via Bordesley Street, Pickford Street and Fazeley Street. Pedestrian access maintained at all times.	24/7	4 April 2019	12 April 2019
Phase 3: Road closure in place on New Canal Street junctions with Curzon Street and Banbury Street. Diversion via Fazeley Street, Great Barr Street and Lawley Middleway. Pedestrian access maintained at all times.	24/7	15 April 2019	24 April 2019


